WINTER INFORMATION

SIDEWALK SHOVELING Owners or occupants of property in the City of Delavan are responsible for removing snow and/or ice from public sidewalks abutting their property.

If the snow or ice on the sidewalk at 6:00 a.m. has not been removed by 8:00 p.m. the same day, the City will remove the snow and/or ice at the property owners expense, charged at \$100.00 per hour in 15 minute increments for labor and equipment, with a minimum of \$40.00 for the first 15 minutes.

CITY DROP-OFF COMPOST SITE (Street Department), 490 Richmond Road, hours are 7:00 a.m. to 3:15 p.m., Monday thru Friday, available to all City of Delavan residents for the disposal of brush, leaves, or grass clippings with no fee charged. Placement of materials into the dumpsters is not provided by the City.

Commercial companies engaged in the business or practice of landscaping or yard maintenance are **not** to deposit any material at the drop-off compost site.

HOLIDAY TREE COLLECTION The Street Department will be collecting holiday trees during the month of January as weather and manpower allow. The trees must be at the edge of the roadway without light strings, ornaments, or other metal objects including tree stands or plastic bags. Wreaths, garlands, etc. should be placed with your regular refuse. No phone call is necessary for pick-up.
